

UNIVERSITY OF CAMERINO 5 SCHOLARSHIPS RESERVED FOR FEMALE STUDENTS FROM AFGHANISTAN

The University of Camerino, in consideration of the Afghan emergency, is awarding 5 scholarships for female students from Afghanistan enrolling in the academic year 2021/2022, in one of the Degree courses offered by UNICAM.

The duration of the scholarship is:

- 3 academic years for the Bachelor Degree courses;
- 5 academic years for the one-tier Master Degree courses;
- 2 academic years for the Master Degree courses.

The scholarship includes:

- Food and lodging in the Halls of Residence for 12 months;
- Exemption from university fees (except for regional fees of 140€ and the virtual revenue stamp of 16€)
- Expenses related to the registration to the National Health System, sport facilities and application for the residence permit;
- Monthly grant of 150€ for didactic material (paid every 4 months)

This scholarship is not compatible with other scholarships awarded by UNICAM, ERDIS (Regional Body for the Right to Education of the Marche Region) or other National public institutions.

To participate in the call, candidates must:

- 1. have an Afghan citizenship;
- 2. have an academic qualification awarded by a foreign institution/University that is recognized by the Italian System of Education for access to the Degree courses;
- 3. not been enrolled in another Italian University for the academic year 2021/2022.

The applications missing specified documentation or applications lacking the above requirements will not be accepted.

Students must submit their application within 23 December 2021 at welcome@unicam.it, attaching:

- documents related to university qualification appropriate for enrollment.
- contents and syllabuses of the previous academic career;
- in case of lack of documents, the candidates will be interviewed by the Committee on the former studies.

The University Committee will formulate a merit-ranking list following the mentioned criteria and taking into consideration merit, performance, language proficiency.

In case of equal rankings, priority and preference will go to:

- the younger of the candidates;
- candidates escaped from Afghanistan through airlift or other way with a recent limited territoriality visa;
- candidates who have applied for asylum or family reunion.



Successful candidates will receive notification by email by the Welcome Office. Acceptance or non-acceptance must be communicated by email to <u>welcome@unicam.it</u>.

The scholarship will be supplied after:

- the enrollment finalization;
- the opening of a bank account/bank card with IBAN;
- signature of the Acceptance Declaration of the scholarship;

To maintain the scholarship, the students enrolled at UNICAM must:

- achieve a min. of 20 credits within 30 September 2022 for the first academic year;
- achieve a min. of 30 credits for the following academic years;

Extra-credits or the recognition of the previous exams will not take into consideration in the calculation of the credits.

This summary of the official call for application has to be considered just as a help to the candidates interested in applying.
