



UNIVERSITY OF CAMERINO – REOPENING OF THE CALL ACT. N. 12/2015

N. 7 GRANTS FOR STUDENTS IN DOUBLE/JOINT DEGREE IN EU AND NON EU COUNTRIES

The University of Camerino opens a call for:

- n. 7 grants for the achievement of a double/joint degree in EU and non EU Countries for a period from 5 to 10 months.

The mobility is aimed for the candidate to achieve a double/joint degree with the guarantee of academic recognition of the credits, previously agreed with responsible of each study course.

The mobility period is up to 30 September 2015.

How to apply

Students enrolled in UNICAM wishing to participate in the program can apply no later than 13:00h on **5 June 2015** at Mobility and International Relations Office, Area Student Services and Internationalization (ASSINT), via Pieragostini 18, 62032 Camerino.

For applications sent by mail the date of the postmark will not be considered.

The application form is available at the Mobility and International Relations Office or can be downloaded from the Unicam web page.

Who can apply

To participate in the competition students must:

1. be enrolled in any degree course of 1 and 2 cycle (bachelor / master / one-tier degree) at UNICAM;
2. be registered at least at the second year course if enrolled in a first level degree course or a one-tier degree course;
3. be up to date with tuition fees payment;
4. have a competence of a foreign language of B1 level, at least.

Documents to enclose

The following documentation must be enclosed:

1. Copy of the on-line student record book;
2. self-declaration of language knowledge (level of competence);



3. motivational questionnaire;
4. academic curriculum agreed in advance and signed by the responsible of each Course of Study with the exams to be taken abroad

Examination board, selection criteria and evaluation

The Examination board will be composed by the Delegate for international mobility, by 3 representatives of the International Relations and by the Responsible of the International Relation Office.

The final ranking will be made in accordance with the following criteria:

- academic performance: max 60%;
- evaluation of the motivational questionnaire: 20%;
- language competence higher than B1 level: max 20%.

Academic performance is measured by 1) ratio between number of acquired credits and expected number of credits to be acquired from time of enrollment to the submission of this application (usually, it is expected that a student will acquire 60 credits per year). For students that are enrolled in second level degree programs (Masters) the undergraduate curriculum will be also taken into account; 2) weighted average grade.

In the motivational questionnaire, attached to the application form, the candidate must report the study program for the Double/Joint Degree.

The language competence will be evaluated only if higher than B1 level through international certifications or through a possible test/interview after the evaluations outcome.

Ranking , Acceptance and Disclaimers

The three final rankings will be available at the Mobility and International Relations Office by **11 June, 2015**.

The minimum required score is 60/100.



Amount of Grant

The grant amount will not cover the full cost of the stay abroad, but it will at least partly compensate the additional costs in the host Country:

- € 2500,00 for double/joint degree in non EU Countries (5 months period);
- € 5000,00 for double/joint degree in non EU Countries (10 months period);
- € 400,00, monthly, for the double/joint degree in EU Countries (from 5 to 10 months)

The student will receive a first installment, corresponding to the 80% of the total amount of the grant within one month from departure. The remaining 20% will be paid at the end of the study period, after the submission of the final documentation:

- certificate of registration issued by the host University and completion of the individual report for Double Degree;
- report on the activity carried out with an official declaration of the host Institution as well as the positive assessment of the tutor Unicam for study abroad.
