"AESTHETIC MEDICINE AND THERAPEUTICS"
Academic years 2016/2017 and 2017/2018**

The University of Camerino,

- GIVEN** the University By-Laws, issued with the University Rector Decree No. 194 of July 30, 2012 and published in the Official Gazette of the Italian Republic – General Series – First Part, No. 200 of 28 August 2012;
- GIVEN** the "Regulations for the Establishment and Functioning of University Master Programs, Postgraduate Qualification and Professional Development Courses," promulgated by the Rector Decree No. 9 of 12/11/2013;

the International Two-Year University Level 2 Master in "Aesthetic Medicine and Therapeutics" (stage in Athens, Greece)

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

Aesthetic medicine has of late become an important reality in medicine and in society at large. The culture of medicine of wellness, so pervasive in industrialized Western society, risks presenting consumers with inadequate or superficial information that often leads to "do it yourself" remedies that may be ineffective or even harmful.

In this context, advanced university formation provided by pre-eminent figures in the sector who work on an international or national level, would afford safeguards for consumers and offer the high level of quality that should be the ambition of a public university.

A unique characteristic of the Master, developed to meet the needs of working physicians, is its e-learning format for the theoretical part of the program. The face-to-face and practical parts of the formation will be conducted in a series of intensive internships (stage). This latter can be done in Athens (Greece) in collaboration with the Venus Medicine. **The Master's language is English.**

PROFESSIONAL PROFILE

The Master provides high level formation for professionals who will work in their own studios, multispecialist centers, wellness centers, gyms, spas or hotel complexes with specialized sports and health and beauty facilities, as well as in companies that develop and manufacture products for the sector.

STRUCTURE OF THE MASTER

The Master is composed of 21 units, each of which is in turn formed of one or more modules, for a total of 33 modules. A module includes a series of lessons, most of which employ e-learning, and a library in which learners can find carefully selected reference material that would otherwise be difficult to obtain. Each module is followed by an on-line test; once this test has been passed, the student may access the following modules.

In addition to modules, there will be *case studies* that focus on some practical aspects of the management and practice of cosmetic medicine. There will also be on-line *forum* sessions in which a teacher guides discussion about a topic on the basis of preparatory material she or he will have previously sent to students. Other teachers will also participate in the discussion.

After the first and second year of the Master and before presentation and defence of the thesis, the student must pass a face-to-face exam on the fundamental content of the program of studies. At the end of the Master, the student must presents and discuss her or his Master's thesis, as one of the requirements to earn the degree.

At the end of the program, participants will receive the two-year university level two Master degree.

THE MASTER PROGRAM ABROAD

In line with the international vocation of the Master, which is organized in collaboration with the European Medical Association (EMA), it will be delivered in part in other nations of the European Union, in order to provide an offering that meets the needs of international users.

INTERNSHIP (obligatory)

In addition to face-to-face lessons, e-learning and practical activities, there will be a six week internship each year. These activities will be done in Athens (Greece) in collaboration with Venus Medicine. Dates for 2017: 21-22 April, 4-7 May, 1-4 June, 6-9 July, 28-30 September- 1 October, 16-19 November. Dates for 2018 will communicated after passing the exam at the end of the first year.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The Master is open to applicants who are employed, unemployed, or have never been employed, and who have a degree in Medicine and Surgery, earned in at least five year program, a license for medical practice and membership in the appropriate professional registers or, for foreigners, equivalent organization.

All participants in the Master must have the computer skills and familiarity with internet use needed to follow the interactive e-learning lessons. **They must have a multi-media personal**

computer with broadband service, and possess sufficient knowledge of English, which will be the only language used in the Master.

Enrolment in the Master is not possible for those who in this academic year are already enrolled in an undergraduate, master, specialization, or doctoral degree program, or another course involving a year-long commitment (Italian law 270/04, art. 5, c. 2).

TERMS AND MODALITIES OF THE ENTRANCE TEST

Admission to the Master depends upon a favourable evaluation of the applicant's curriculum vitae et studiorum. If the number of applicants exceeds the maximum number of students allowed in the program, evaluation of the curriculum will be followed by a personal interview, which will count 30% in formulating the ranking of applicants.

Previous documented activity in the area of the Master will serve as a preferential requisite for admission.

ANNUAL EXAMINATIONS

For each module conducted through e-learning there will be an on-line test. By May/June of each of the two years of the Master there could be a test covering all the activities conducted up to that point. This test may be conducted face-to-face or online.

At the end of the first year of the Master, students must pass a face-to-face examination to confirm that they have mastered the fundamental aspects developed during the year.

The following documents must be sent with the application:

- signed declaration (Attachment A) available together with the application form;
- copy of a valid identification document;
- curriculum vitae in European format;
- university degree certificate (with legalized translation in Italian or English language);
- other degrees and certificates useful for the selection.

ISSUING OF THE DIPLOMA

At the conclusion of the Master, only those who are up to date with their fee payments and have attended at least 75% of the face-to-face lessons will be able to take the final examination.

Having passed the final examination, they will receive the University of Camerino Diploma for the University II Level Master.

After the application deadline, an applicant who decides against starting the Master will not be able to receive reimbursement for the amount paid.

Application to the Master entails tacit consent to the publication of personal data and results of the selection examination on the website of the Master, in line with D.L. 196 of June 30, 2003.
