SAS AWARD 2019

CALL FOR APPLICATION

Art. 1

1. The SAS Award 2019 is granted to three PhD students demonstrating outstanding research performance. The Award consists of a benefit of 1.500 € (supported by funds from the '5 per mille program, 2016'). The competition is open to doctoral students enrolled in the second or third year of study. Previous winners of the SAS Award are not eligible to apply.
2. The selection process will be based on the evaluation of the candidates' scientific profile, participation in the SAS activities and of a research product obtained during the doctoral programme.

Art. 2

1. To participate, candidates must fill the application forms hereby enclosed and send it by e-mail to **postlaurea@unicam.it** (deadline: **June 3, 2019**).
2. The following documents must be enclosed:
 - a. CV, written in English, in Europass format.
 - b. The research product that the candidate selects to compete for the **SAS AWARD 2019**;
 - c. Up to three pages A4 describing the research conducted within the doctoral programme (SAS AWARD nomination form), giving a clear indication of the candidates contribution to the product proposed for evaluation, and in accordance with the research evaluation criteria listed below, in both Phase1 and Phase2.

Applicants not respecting these guidelines will be excluded from the competition.

Art. 3

1. The evaluation process consists of two phases:

Phase 1 - Five members of the SAS Council evaluate the candidate's CV and Participation to the SAS activities

EVALUATION CRITERIA (Weight for the final assessment **50%**):

*1 = Low; 2 = Sufficient; 3 = Good; 4 = Very Good; 5 = Excellent

To be evaluated for the "Research experience", the candidate should provide all information that might be useful as evidence of the acquired research skills, such as attendance of stages, exchange programmes, mobility programmes, summer schools etc. To be evaluated in the "Research results", the candidate should provide any relevant information about:

- granted projects, publications, reports, patents;
- poster presentations, invited lectures/presentations.

The candidate must also provide information about her/his individual contribution to the obtained research results.

To be evaluated for the "Participation to the SAS activities" the candidate should fill the reserved area on the SAS webpage.

Phase 2 - The research product selected to compete for the SAS Award 2019 will be evaluated by two independent, anonymous referees chosen by the SAS Council on the basis of their research domain.



