

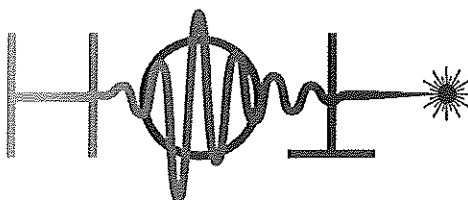

HAVING REGARD TO Legislative Decree No 17/2008 on standards for admitting third-country nationals for the purposes of scientific research;

HAVING REGARD TO the provisions on taxation, as per art. 4 of Law No. 476 of 13 August 1984;



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HAVING REGARD TO the provisions on social security, referred to in art. 2, para. 26 and following, of Law No. 335 of 8 August 1995 and subsequent modifications;

HAVING REGARD TO the provisions on compulsory maternity leave provided for in the Decree of the Minister of Labour and Social Security of 12 July 2007, published in the Official Journal of 23 October 2007, No. 247;

HAVING REGARD TO the provisions concerning sick leave, referred to in art. 1, para. 788 of Law No. 296 of 27 December 2006, and subsequent amendments;

HAVING REGARD TO art. 22 of Law No. 240 of 30 December 2010, the universities and research institutes may confer, as provided for in para. 7 of the said article, research grants of an amount determined by the same body which awards the allowances on the basis of a minimum amount established by a decree of the Minister;

HAVING REGARD TO the Ministerial Decree No. 102/2011 - registered by the Court of Auditors on 13 May 2011 - referring to art. 22, para. 7 of Law No 240/2010 about the minimum allowance of a research grant;

HAVING REGARD TO the project "HOT Hybrid Optomechanical Technologies (Principal Investigator for the University of Camerino Prof. David Vitali, School of Science and Technology, Physics Division), funded under H2020 Programme, Call FETPROACT-2016, Grant Agreement number 732894 and the Legal and Financial Provision of H2020 Amended Model Grant Agreement;

A public selection procedure, based on qualifications, for the conferral of a research grant is open at the School of Science and Technology –Physics Division.

Experienced researcher definition:

candidates must, at the application deadline, be in possession of a doctoral degree, or have at least four years of full-time equivalent research experience.

This is measured from the date when they obtained the degree which formally entitles them to embark on a doctorate, either in the country in which the degree was obtained or in the country in which the research training is provided, irrespective of whether or not a doctorate was envisaged.

Art. 2

Admissibility criteria of the candidates

Applicants must be in possession of admission requirements and eligibility criteria at the application deadline.

Physical fitness to the job is required. In accordance with legislation in force the University Administration reserves the right to ask successful candidates to take medical exams.

Applicants are not admitted to the selection procedure, if they are excluded from any active electorate; or have a degree of kinship, up to and including 4th grade, with a professor of the School or the unit where the research project takes place, as well as with the Rector, the General Director or a member of the University Board of Governors in accordance with art.18, para. 1, lett. b) and c), Law no. 240/2010.

Foreign citizens must also meet the following requirements:

- a) to enjoy full rights as citizens in the state of origin or provenance;
- b) except for the Italian citizenship, to meet all other requirements;

Anytime and by reasoned decision the University Administration can exclude applicants from the selection procedure because of missing requirements.

Applicants cannot be admitted to this selection procedure, if they have already been awarded research grants by any other institution or agency in accordance with Law no. 240/2010 for a period, which summed up with the duration of the current grant, exceeds 4 years on the whole. If the grant has been awarded during a doctoral programme without grants, that period is not counted.

Furthermore, applicants would not be admitted to this selection procedure, if they hold or have held contracts such as post-doctoral grants or fixed-term Research Fellow contracts with the University of Camerino or any other Italian university in accordance with art. 22 and art. 24, Law no. 240/2010, as well as with other institutions or agencies in accordance with art. 22, para. 1, Law no. 240/2010 for a period exceeding 12 years, even if not continuous, when summed with the contract duration of the current selection announcement. According to legislation in force periods on maternity or sick leave are not counted.

Art. 3

Application and submission deadline

Applications, drafted on ordinary paper according to the attached form (Annex 1), together with relevant documentation for the purposes of the selection procedure, addressed to the Rector, are to be sent by registered mail with advice of delivery to the following address: **Campus Universitario -**

Object of the Application: HOT Hybrid Optomechanical Technologies- ER Position – Prof. David Vitali.

In order to verify compliance with the application deadline, the stamp will be credited to the date of the accepting post office, whereas, in case of hand-over, the date of receipt of the application will be valid.

The selection procedure announcement will be published on the University of Camerino website at www.unicam.it (link to Online services), on MIUR website (Ministry of Education, University and Research) at <http://bandi.miur.it> and on the European Union website at <http://ec.europa.eu/euraxess/>.

Applications must be drafted according to Attachment 1, which, according to legislation in force must contain all requested information. Failure to comply with this requirement entails exclusion from the selection.

The University Administration is by no means responsible for missing out communications due to inexact address details provided by the candidate or for failed or late communication of address changes. Moreover, the Administration is not responsible either for inefficiencies of the postal service not due to the Administration itself, or for causes due to a third party, or for unforeseeable circumstances or force majeure, or for failed return of the advice of delivery of registered letters.

In full awareness of potential civil, criminal and administrative liabilities, in the application candidates must declare:

1. surname, name, place and date of birth;
2. citizenship (Italian or one of EU member states);
3. if Italian, their electoral register, specifying the district, or give reasons for not being enrolled, or for having been cancelled, if applicable;
4. to have a clean criminal record and not to have pending lawsuits, if applicable;
5. awarded post-graduate degree, grades, date and awarding University;
6. awarded doctoral degree, date and awarding University;
7. not to have been awarded any other scholarship, fellowship or research grant. Applicants commit themselves to give them up, in case of their being successful in the current selection procedure;
8. to be physically fit to the job;
9. permanent or temporary address and postal code, where all communications about this selection procedure are to be sent;
10. EU citizens must also declare to enjoy full rights as citizens in their state of origin or provenance, or reasons for failing to enjoy them and to have a fair command of the Italian language;
11. to master the foreign language requested by the selection announcement (art. 1);
12. not to have a degree of kinship, up to and including 4th grade, with a professor of the School proposing the recruitment, as well as with the Rector, General Director or a member of the University Board of Governors.

Non-EU applicants must also declare, under their own responsibility,

- their citizenship



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Disabled applicants must explicitly request for assistance proper to their disability, if needed, in accordance with Law no. 104/1992.

4. the qualification awarded abroad for admission to this selection:
 - a. in original or in a copy authenticated by an Italian authority, legalized and accompanied by a certified or sworn translation;
 - b. attached the declaration of value or the transcripts of the examinations taken, concerning the degree required for participation;
5. Annex 5 regarding any assignments or professional activities carried out and positions held in private law entities governed or financed by the public administration, in accordance with art. 15, para. 1, letter c of Legislative Decree No. 33/2013.
6. a copy of a valid identity document;
7. a copy of the tax identification number (national identification number, social security number etc.).

In order to ensure the widest possible participation, candidates, holding a degree awarded abroad, who are not able to submit it together with the application, as indicated in the previous paragraph, must submit it in copy together with a translation in Italian or in English. In case the applicant wins the competition, the qualification awarded abroad for admission to this selection will have to be submitted according to point 4 (four) of the above paragraph. This is a necessary condition for the contract stipulation in any case. Applicants not belonging to the European Union, who are not yet in possession of the Residence Permit in Italy, cannot start their research project, if they do not respect this procedure.

Evidence of qualifications may also be given by a personal declaration of certification in accordance with art. 46, D.P.R. no. 445/2000 (Annex 2).

Qualifications deemed to be relevant for the purposes of this selection procedure must be submitted within the deadline for application.

Qualifications and publications can be submitted in plain copy accompanied by a declaration in lieu of affidavit as of Annex 3, in accordance with art. 47, D.P.R. no. 445/2000, where to state in full awareness that the submitted copies of academic titles and publications are true and faithful copies of the originals (Annex 3).

If not signed in front of the person entitled to receive them, a photocopy of an identity document must be attached to the aforementioned declarations..

The arrangements for Italian citizens apply to citizens of the European Union. Non-EU nationals resident in Italy may use a declaration in lieu of affidavit limited to cases where they



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are able to prove personal, factual and personal qualities, certified or attested by Italian public or private individuals within the meaning of Article 3, para. 2, of the Presidential Decree of 28 December 2000 No. 445.

Certificates issued by the competent authorities of foreign states must comply with the provisions in force in the hosting country and must also be legalized by the competent Italian consular authorities.

Publications must be produced in the original language; they must be translated into one of the following languages: Italian, French, English, German and Spanish only if the original is produced in a language other than the ones mentioned above. The translated texts may be presented in typed copies, together with the text printed in the original language, accompanied by a declaration in lieu of affidavit attesting the conformity of the translated text.

Documents, qualifications and publications posted to the University after the submission deadline will not be considered.

The truthfulness and correctness of the successful candidate's self-certified acts, facts, and personal data will be verified (sample-checked) by the University of Camerino.

Applicant's surname, name and address must be clearly written on the envelope.

It is not allowed to refer to documents or publications already submitted for other selection procedures.

Art. 4

Selection Board and evaluation

The Selection Board is appointed by the Rector and consists of three members, the professor in charge of the research project and two external members proposed by the School Council, and chosen among qualified academic staff of the research area of interest.

Board members' names and curricula will be published on the University website.

Once the evaluation procedure has come to an end, the Selection Board takes minutes according to a template provided for by the Human Resources Dept.

The selection is based on the evaluation of qualifications. The maximum score to be awarded is 70 points out of 70.

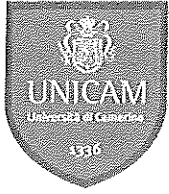
Qualifications, relevant to the research activity will be taken into account as follows:

- Academic qualifications: master's degree or equivalent awarded in Italy or abroad; doctoral degree, any other postgraduate qualifications, degrees etc.: maximum 30 points;
- Scientific professional curriculum: scientific track record documenting aptitude to research, contracts stipulated with and/or fellowships awarded by Italian, overseas, international institutions, educational and research achievements deemed useful for the selection and prized by the Committee in relation to the research activity to be performed, etc.: maximum 40 points.

The Selection Committee will also evaluate creativity and autonomy shown by candidates' scientific publications.

Successful candidates must earn at least 50 points out of 70.

The research grants will be awarded to the most qualified candidates.



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If the successful candidate withdraws before the beginning of the research activity, or in case of an early termination of the contract, because of unjustifiable failed beginning of the research activity, the grants can be awarded to applicants coming next in the ranking list of successful candidates.

Grants are conferred under the provisions of a private law contract.

Grants are effective beginning the first day of the month after the signature of the contract.

The Scientific Project Coordinator will testify the beginning of the research activity by sending a declaration to the Rector.

Grants will be paid on a monthly basis.

At the end of the procedure the Selection Board will express an overall evaluation of each candidate and draw up a ranking list of eligible candidates, which will be submitted to the Rector for approval, in order to come immediately into effect.

The most deserving candidate will receive a written communication of his being awarded the research grant.

Art. 5

Prohibition of accumulation, incompatibility, leave, interruptions

Grant holders cannot be awarded any other kind of grants, while under this contract, except for those awarded by national or international institutions to integrate this research activity with periods abroad.

Grant holders cannot be, at the same time, enrolled in undergraduate, postgraduate, doctoral courses with grant, medical school courses in Italy or abroad.

Grant holders can be engaged in teaching and be in charge of specific courses and/or teaching modules.

The Department or School, where grant holders are working, is responsible for the profitable performance of grant holders research activity, that is why teaching cannot exceed 60 hours.

Compatible with the assigned research activity and subject to a written authorisation by his/her tutor, heard the Director of the School, grant holders can take part to researches and consulting services commissioned to the University by third parties. They have the right to a share of paid out provisions in accordance with the legislation into force regulating the matter.

Research activity and grants can be interrupted for maternity or sick leave, provided that the length of the research activity is not reduced because of the abovementioned interruptions.

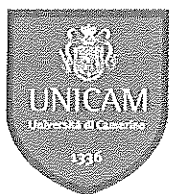
Up to thirty days leave is not considered an interruption and lost time must not be made up.

Grant holders, employed by a public body or agency, must be given unpaid leave for a period equivalent to the duration of the research grant.

Art. 6

Rights and duties of grant holders

Grant holders participate in research activities of the School research programmes and may collaborate with students on research for dissertations or doctoral theses. Grant holders are entitled, for the purposes of carrying out their research activities, to use University structures and resources and to make use of the services provided for researchers, in accordance with the School regulations in force.



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The research activity may partially take place in structures or institutions external to the School, subject to an authorisation by the School Council itself.

The University encourages mobility and study periods abroad. If such is the case grant holders are entitled to reimbursement for travel and accommodation expenses as provided by an appropriate University Internal Regulation.

Grant holders are obliged to submit a detailed annual written report to the School Council covering the research activities carried out and results achieved together with an opinion from the Scientific Project Head.

Grant holders' contracts may be terminated, in case:

- a. the research activity is unjustifiably postponed;
- b. the research activity is unjustifiably suspended for more than 10 days;
- c. a violation of the incompatibility regime is performed;
- d. a negative evaluation on the research activity by the structure where the grant holder is working is given.

Delays and interruptions can be justified just in case of duly attested serious illness or force majeure.

Grant holders funded under H2020 projects are obliged to meet additional obligations and provisions eventually foreseen by the Grant Agreement and the legal and financial rules of the programme.

Maternity leave is regulated by the Decree of the Ministry of Labor and Social Security of 27 July 2007, published in the Italian Official Journal no. 247 of 23 October 2007 and, matters regarding sick leave are regulated by art. 1, para. 788, Law no. 296/2006 and subsequent modifications.

During the period of obligatory maternity leave, the maternity subsidy paid by INPS in accordance with art. 5 of the abovementioned decree of 27 July 2007 shall be supplemented by the University to match the entire amount of the remuneration due to the research grant holder.

Grant holders may withdraw from the contract upon thirty days written notice.

Grant holders undertake to comply with the provisions of the Code of Ethics issued by this University with Rector's Decree no. 16 of 2 March 2015.

Art. 7 Scientific Project Coordinator

The Scientific Project Coordinator is a full-tenured professor or a researcher, under whose guidance the research activity is carried out, as established by the research grant.

Art. 8 Contract

The winner of the selection procedure is invited to stipulate a private law contract usually effective from the beginning of the following month. As described, the contract does not in any way imply academic staff permanent employment and does not count towards tenure track positions at Italian Universities.



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Upon termination of the contract, grant holders will have to submit a report on his/her research activity.

Art. 9

Return of documents and publications

Within 6 months from the publication date of the Rector's Decree, containing the approval of records, and expired the period abided by law for appeals, candidates can ask back their documents (academic titles and publications), except in case of ongoing legal disputes, either in person or through an authorised person, from the Human Resources Department of the University of Camerino – Via Gentile III da Varano 62032 Camerino (MC).

Art. 10

Fiscal and social security dispositions

Research grants referred to in this Regulation are subject to the fiscal provisions contained in art. 4, Law no. 476/1984 and subsequent amendments and integrations, and to the social security provisions contained in art. 2, para. 26, Law no. 335/1995 and subsequent amendments and integrations.

Art. 11

Processing of personal data

In accordance with D.Lgs. no. 196/2003 all personal data, supplied by candidates will be exclusively processed for the purposes relevant to the current selection procedure for the conferral of the research grants and for recruitment procedures.

Art. 12

Public access to official records

In compliance with the transparency obligations set forth in the Legislative Decree of 14 March 2013 No. 33 the selection procedure, the list of candidates, their curriculum and the ranking list will be published on the University's website at <http://www.unicam.it/bandi>.

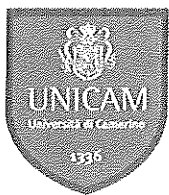

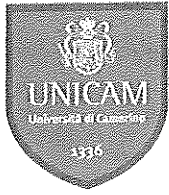

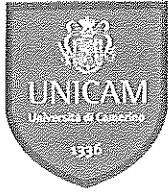
