DECREES

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Article 1

Position 1 Description / Research Aims ESR 1	Objectives: The task of ESR1 will be to prepare and test different nanoparticle technology formats for imaging, accommodating payloads, and specific targeting of pain-associated cells or molecules in DRG. We aim to control the particle size and drug content by taking four independent processing parameters and two characteristics of the material into account. The interdependencies

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	<p>between processing, material parameters, and the subsequent nanoparticle characteristics will be optimised to allow efficient production of drug-loaded polymer nanoparticles. This level of understanding should rapidly assist the project to have protocols for the production of optimal PLGA nanoparticles in place. Expected results: PLGA, which is already FDA approved, will be modified to produce optimal release kinetics of encapsulated payloads into DRG. The group will make structural changes, e.g. hydrophobicity, charge, biodegradation rate, and molecular weight, to make/produce/manufacture the optimal release formulation. We also expect to have drug-loaded PLGA nanoparticles by using two emulsification-solvent evaporation methods: homogenisation and sonication. Planned secondments: To LUMC for 2x2 months (m13-14 and m37-38) to learn about surface chemistry and targeting. To PERC for 3 months (m25-27) to learn small animal imaging and to perform molecular imaging experiments. Scientific risk assessment: Nanoparticles that are less than 300 nm in diameter will be chosen, since bigger nanoparticles are less biocompatible and have a shorter half-life. The risk is to produce batches with inconsistent nanoparticle size. However, we have protocols in place to reduce and eliminate this risk. The particle size of drug-loaded PLGA nanoparticles is effectively controlled by the amount of shear stress transferred from the energy source to the organic phase. This is influenced by the type of applied energy, aqueous phase volume, and polymer concentration in the organic solvent. When we would increase the drug-polymer interactions, the drug content of these nanoparticles may then be controlled by reducing the diffusion of the drug from the organic to the aqueous phase during the solvent evaporation stage of the preparation.</p>
<p>Position 2 Description / Research Aims ESR 5</p>	<p>Objectives: The task of ESR5 is to develop genetic modification technology and tools (transgenic mice, knock-out mice, and replication-defective viral vectors) with the long-term goal to promote functional neuroregeneration of injured spinal cord tracts. Protocols will be developed where <i>in vivo</i> gene transfer technology is employed to modulate the response of neurons and glia cells to injury to provide new insights into the molecular and cellular mechanisms that promote and/or inhibit neuroregeneration. Expected results: An understanding of the structural and functional aspects of nerve regeneration and plasticity in the injured and intact PNS in relation to pain. The focus will narrow in on the role of transcription, neurotrophic factors, and chemorepulsive proteins. These results will prove to be relevant in the context of neuropathic pain and in advancing our understanding of how neurons survive injury and how nerve cells form and maintain new functional connections after injury. Planned secondments: To EDIN for 6 months (m12-17) to learn about macrophages/inflammation imaging. To UVA for 3</p>

	months (m31-33) to learn about nanoparticles and activatable probe design and to HMR for 2 months (m34-35). Scientific risk assessment: There is a risk that the genetic modification technology, developed in this work package (transgenic mice, knock-out mice, and replication-defective viral vectors), may take longer than expected to be completed and utilised. If this is indeed the case, we would use commercial and fee- for-service outlets.

Article 3

Selection Committee and evaluation criteria

The Selection Committee is appointed by the Rector and is composed of three members, upon proposal of the School Board, and it is composed by the Responsible of Research project and by other two members plus a proxy, Professors or Researchers whose competences and skills belong to research area of the project. Their curricula will be published on the University website.

In order to keep record of the selection procedure, minutes are taken by the Selection Committee.

The selection is based on the evaluation of qualifications and on interview (in presence or by skype).

Qualifications, relevant to the research activity will be taken into account as follows:

- Academic qualifications: master's degree or equivalent awarded in Italy or abroad.
- Scientific professional curriculum: scientific track record documenting aptitude to research, contracts stipulated with and/or fellowships awarded by Italian, overseas, international institutions, educational and research achievements deemed useful for the selection and prized by the Committee in relation to the research activity to be performed, etc..

The Selection Committee will also evaluate creativity and autonomy shown by candidates' scientific publications.

Article 4

Rights and duties of grant holders

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Grant holder carries out research activities under the research programmes adopted by the School. In order to carry out their research activity, grant holder are entitled to use facilities, equipment and services provided for researchers in accordance with the School regulations in force.

The research activities can be developed in other partner Institutions as provided by the Grant Agreement.

The recruited researcher must respect:

- the obligation to work full-time;
- the obligation to work exclusively for the action;
- the obligation not to receive for activities carried out in the frame of the action, other income than those received from the beneficiary (or any other entity referred to in Annex 1 of the Grant Agreement);
- the obligation to inform the beneficiary as soon as possible of any events or circumstances likely to affect the agreement;
- the arrangements related to the intellectual property rights between the beneficiary and the researcher during implementation of the action and afterwards;
- the obligation to maintain confidentiality;
- the obligation to ensure the visibility of EU funding in communications or publications and in applications for the protection of results;

Grant holder are obliged to submit a detailed semestral written report to the School Board covering the research activities carried out and results achieved together with an opinion by the Coordinator.

Grant holder's contract may be terminated, in case:

- a. the research activity is unjustifiably postponed;
- b. a negative evaluation on the research activity by the department, where the grant holder is working, is given.

Delays and interruptions can be justified just in case of duly attested serious illness or force majeure. Maternity leave is regulated by the Decree of the Ministry of Labour and Social Security of 27 July 2007, published in the Italian Official Journal no. 247 of 23 October 2007, while matters regarding sick leave are regulated by art. 1, para. 788, Law no. 296/2006 and subsequent modifications. During the period of obligatory maternity leave, the maternity subsidy paid by INPS in accordance with art. 5 of the abovementioned Decree of 27 July 2007 shall be supplemented by the University to match the entire amount of the remuneration due to the research grant holder.

Grant holders may withdraw from the contract upon 30 days written notice.

In any case the length of the research contract cannot exceed the expiration date of the project.

Article 5

Contractual arrangement

The fellowship is governed by a contract of the Director General. The winner of the selection

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procedure is invited to stipulate a private law contract usually effective from the beginning of the following month. As such, the contract does not in any way imply academic staff permanent employment and does not count towards tenure track positions at Italian University.

Upon termination of the contract, grant holder will have to submit a report on their research activity.

Article 6 Return of documents and publications

Within 6 months from the end of the selection procedure, candidates can ask back their documents (academic titles and publications), except in case of on-going legal disputes, in person from the Human Resources Department of the University of Camerino – Via Gentile III Da Varano, 62032 Camerino (MC), or by written request.

Article 7 Fiscal and social security provisions

Allowances referred to in this Regulation are subject to the fiscal provisions of art. 4, Law No 476/1984 and subsequent amendments and integrations, and to the social security provisions of art. 2, para. 26, Law No 335/1995 and subsequent amendments and integrations.
