HAVING REGARD TO the Project "OMT – Optomechanical Technologies" approved by the European Commission and funded under the H2020 Marie Curie Skłodowska Innovative Training Network (ITN) - European Training Network (ETN)", Grant agreement No: 722923, coordinated by the EPFL - ECOLE POLYTECHNIQUE FEDERALE DE LAUSANNE, Switzerland;

IN ACCORDANCE WITH the European Commission's general rule that, when an employment contract cannot be stipulated, the researcher shall be recruited under a status equivalent to a fixed-amount fellowship, and be compatible with national legislation of the host organization. According to Title II of the EC Regulation No 883/2004 regarding the coordination of social security systems and general principles of the Commission Recommendation, dated 11 May 2005 on the European Charter - Code of Conduct for the Recruitment of Researchers, the employment contract must ensure full coverage of welfare and social security. Furthermore, in the case of Marie Curie Actions - ETN, the host organisation must ensure that the coverage for at least sickness and maternity benefits, invalidity and accidents at work and occupational diseases is provided for to the researcher.

WHEREAS a private contract with no relationship of subordination is the appropriate form of contract to recruit European Researchers for a period equal to 36 months, the appropriate ER selection procedures can be started;

DECREES

Article 1 Available position and eligible candidates

A public selection procedure for the recruitment for an Early Stage Researcher, within the scope of the research program: "OMT – Optomechanical Technologies" - H2020 Marie Curie Skłodowska - Innovative Training Network (ITN) - European Training Network (ETN)", Grant agreement No: 722923, at the School of Science and Technology the University of Camerino is hereby announced. Details on the position:

Secondment periods to be spent in other project Institutions' sites and included in the length of contract, will be scheduled as foreseen by the project.

Mobility allowances are thus defined:

Category 2: *Mobility allowance* In addition to the living allowance, the beneficiary must pay a mobility allowance and for some categories of researchers, a family allowance, as specified in table 1 of the workprogramme. In this context family is defined as persons linked to the researcher by (i) marriage, or (ii) a relationship with equivalent status to a marriage recognized by the legislation of the country or region where this relationship was formalized; or (iii) dependent children who are actually being maintained by the researcher.

So there are two reference amounts depending on the family situation of the researcher at the time of the recruitment of the researcher:

Article 2 Admission requirements

Applications must be submitted within the time limit of 60 days effective from the day following the publication of this announcement. If the aforesaid date is a Saturday or a holiday, the expiring date shall be postponed to the next working day. Failure to comply with this deadline entails exclusion from the selection.

In case of mail delivery the postmark date will prove the respect of deadlines, while in case of hand delivery the University Register Office, Piazza Cavour 19/F 62032 Camerino (MC) will issue a receipt with the delivery date.

 - Declarations (Attachments "B1 and B2") must clearly state:

1. qualifications: date, place of awarding, attendance, marks;

2. publications (scientific articles in particular): author, title, place of publication, journal title and volume number, encyclopedia or treatise they are part of.

These procedures apply to European Union citizens.

Non-European Union citizens, holding a regular permit to stay or residence permit issued by Italian Authorities, may submit the aforementioned declarations in accordance with art. 46 and 47, D.P.R. No. 245/2000 only for those acts, facts, and personal data certifiable or verifiable by Italian State Authorities, without prejudice to special legal and regulatory provisions regarding immigration. Aside from the mentioned cases, non-European Union citizens, holding a regular permit to stay or residence permit, may submit the aforesaid declarations in compliance with international conventions between Italy and the state of origin or provenance in accordance with art. 3, D.P.R. No. 445/2000.

Non-European Union citizens, living abroad must submit copy of relevant qualifications translated into Italian or English, but the candidate acknowledges that the selected candidate is required to provide the official translation and a legal recognition of his/her qualification, in accordance with the national Law of the Host Institution.

Pursuant to D.P.R No. 445/2000 the University Administration reserves the right to verify the truthfulness and correctness of declarations. Any untruthful statement will entail sanctions laid down in the legal provisions applied in this matter (art. 76, D.P.R. No. 445/2000).

If not signed in front of the person entitled to receive and collect them, a photocopy of an identity document must be attached to the aforementioned declarations.

Applicant's surname, name and address must be clearly written on the envelope.

It is not allowed to refer to documents or publications already submitted for other selection procedures.

Article 3 Selection Committee and evaluation criteria

The Selection Committee is appointed by the Rector and is composed of three members, upon proposal of the School Board, and chosen among expert academic staff of the research area of Committee members' names and curricula will be published on the University website.

In order to keep record of the selection procedure, minutes are taken by the Selection Committee.

The selection is based on the evaluation of qualifications. The maximum score to be awarded is 70 points out of 70.

Oualifications, relevant to the research activity will be taken into account as follows:

- Academic qualifications: master's degree or equivalent awarded in Italy or abroad; any other postgraduate qualifications, degrees etc.: maximum 30 points;
- Scientific professional curriculum: scientific track record documenting aptitude to research, contracts stipulated with and/or fellowships awarded by Italian, overseas, international institutions, educational and research achievements deemed useful for the selection and prized by the Committee in relation to the research activity to be performed, etc.: maximum 40 points.

The Selection Committee will also evaluate creativity and autonomy shown by candidates' scientific publications.

Successful candidates must earn at least 50 points out of 70.

Article 4 Rights and duties of grant holders

Grant holders carry out research activities under the research programmes adopted by the School. In order to carry out their research activity, grant holders are entitled to use facilities, equipment and services provided for researchers in accordance with the School regulations in force.

The research activity can be partly carried out at facilities external to the School, in accordance with the guidelines of the Grant Agreement.

The recruited researcher must respect:

- the obligation to work full-time;
- the obligation to work exclusively for the action;
- the obligation not to receive for activities carried out in the frame of the action, other income than those received from the beneficiary (or any other entity referred to in Annex 1 of the Grant Agreement);
- the obligation to inform the beneficiary as soon as possible of any events or circumstances likely to affect the agreement;
- the arrangements related to the intellectual property rights between the beneficiary and the researcher during implementation of the action and afterwards;
- the obligation to maintain confidentiality;
- the obligation to ensure the visibility of EU funding in communications or publications and in applications for the protection of results;

Grant holders are obliged to submit a detailed annual written report to the School Board covering the research activities carried out and results achieved together with an opinion by the Coordinator.

Grant holders' contracts may be terminated, in case:

- a. the research activity is unjustifiably postponed;
- b. the research activity is unjustifiably suspended for more than 10 days;
- c. a violation of the incompatibility regime is performed;
- d. a negative evaluation on the research activity by the department, where the grant holder is working, is given.

Delays and interruptions can be justified just in case of duly attested serious illness or force majeure. Maternity leave is regulated by the Decree of the Ministry of Labour and Social Security of 27 July 2007, published in the Italian Official Journal no. 247 of 23 October 2007, while matters regarding sick leave are regulated by art. 1, para. 788, Law no. 296/2006 and subsequent modifications. During the period of obligatory maternity leave, the maternity subsidy paid by INPS in accordance with art. 5 of the abovementioned Decree of 27 July 2007 shall be supplemented by the University to match the entire amount of the remuneration due to the research grant holder.

Grant holders may withdraw from the contract upon 30 days written notice.

Article 5 Contractual arrangement

The winner of the selection procedure is invited to stipulate a private law contract usually effective from the beginning of the following month. As such, the contract does not in any way imply academic staff permanent employment and does not count towards tenure track positions at Italian University.

Upon termination of the contract, grant holders will have to submit a report on their research activity.

Article 6 Return of documents and publications

Once the aforementioned allowed period will have expired, the University will be by no means responsible for the aforesaid publications.

Article 7 Fiscal and social security provisions

Allowances referred to in this Regulation are subject to the fiscal provisions of art. 4, Law No 476/1984 and subsequent amendments and integrations, and to the social security provisions of art. 2, para. 26, Law No 335/1995 and subsequent amendments and integrations.

Article 8 Processing of personal data

In accordance with D.Lgs. no. 196/2003 all personal data, submitted by candidates, will be collected by the University of Camerino – Human Resources Department, and exclusively processed for evaluation purposes, relevant to the current selection and recruitment procedure for the conferral of the research grant and allowances.

Article 9 Publication
