The Members of the Commission declare that no incompatibility exists, i.e. that no relationships with a degree of kinship or affinity, up to and including the fourth degree, between the members of the Commission or with any of the candidates to be evaluated, exist, and that there are no situations of conflict of interest, pursuant to Articles 51 and 52 of the Code of Civil Procedure. They also declare that they have no criminal convictions, with or without the final judgment, for offences listed in Chapter I of Title II of the Second Book of the Penal Code.

The Commission, having taken note of the indications contained in the announcement, first examines the applications submitted to assess their eligibility, based on the EC MSC rules and as stated in the call, that are: "The Researcher can be of any nationality as long as the rule of mobility

is met. At the time of recruitment by the host organization, researchers must not have resided in the country where the research training activities take place for more than 12 months in the 3 years immediately prior to the recruitment date (and not have carried out their main activity (work, studies, etc.) in the country. The beneficiary to be, at the date of recruitment, an "early stage researcher" (i.e. in the first four years of his/her research career and not having a doctoral degree)". Furthermore in order to be eligible, as specified in the UNICAM grant announcement candidate has to hold a MSc degree in Computer science or related field.

The NON ELIGIBLE candidates are not admitted to the oral exam. The admission to the oral exam for those who did not present a transcript of Master Degree is under the condition to send the transcript before the oral by email to anna.silano@unicam.it.

Then, the Commission establishes the general criteria for assessing the qualifications and the interviews of the candidates.

The Commission shall evaluate the qualifications submitted by the candidates before the interview, according to the following criteria:

- each candidate may be awarded a maximum of 12 points distributed as follows:
 - Candidate's qualification: assessed in term of marks obtained in the previous and congruence with the topic will be assigned a maximum score of 4 points;
 - Research activities: congruence with the topics of the call: Open Data or Software Development will be assigned a maximum score of 4 points.
 - Additional experiences and qualifications congruent with the topic (traineeships, software development activities, software project management etc.) in the area of Open Data and Software Development will be assigned a maximum score of 4 points.

The Candidates will be admitted to the oral exam if they have obtained, in relation to the presentation of their qualifications, a score of 9.

Candidates who must take the oral exam will be notified of the results of the qualifications evaluation together with the convocation. As regards the oral exam, the Commission will ask each candidate questions relating to the academic discipline for which the conferral of the grant is announced and concerning the title of the research project and the research topic.
